



S5 GUIDELINES FOR THE COMPLETION OF THE CHOICE FORM

- S4 into S5 pupils have the following options of choices:
 1. 5 Highers
 2. 4 Highers and 1 National
 3. 3 Highers and 3 Nationals
 4. 2 Highers and 4 Nationals
 5. 1 Higher and 5 Nationals
 6. 6 Nationals
- If you choose **Option 1 or 2** then please leave **one** column blank.
- You should refer to your prognosis report and recommendations from your teachers to help you make your choices and choose the recommended level.
- If you do not have a prognosis for one of your choices, then you must ask the Faculty Head for that subject to sign your choice form.
- It is essential that a parent/guardian has discussed your choices with you and sign your choice form.
- Your Guidance teacher should also sign your choice form before it is submitted.
- **Please hand it in your completed form to the main office by Friday 22nd March 2024.**

College Courses

- College courses are available in column A for school-link courses on a Friday.
- Any online Highers, such as Psychology, should be chosen in column C.
- All courses require an application to be submitted by Monday 18th March. Please see the prospectus or your Guidance teacher for information on how to do this.
- North Highland College will inform pupils of decisions the week starting 6th May.
- Please note that while you are being asked to make choices about your courses, you may have to consider changes to your choices after your results. This will need to be discussed with your Guidance teacher at the start of the term in August.



- Although every attempt will be made to meet your choice of course some classes may not run if there is insufficient demand or if staffing is not available. Re-Coursing after SQA results may lead to changes in classes which will be made by considering a wide variety of factors in relation to individual students and not on a first come first served basis.
